

Inclusion Projects

University Corridors

In 2019, Luiss and the University of Bologna launched the project "University Corridors" in collaboration with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI), welcoming an Eritrean student refugee to Luiss in September 2019.

The student was selected from a UNHCR refugee camp in Ethiopia and has completed the first year of his master's degree program in Rome with great success.

The project was presented as a best practice during the Global Refugee Compact of December 2019. In 2020, the network of University Corridors was expanded to include another 10 Italian universities and Luiss committed to welcoming another student refugee who arrived in Rome in September 2020. As in 2019, the student was selected from a UNHCR refugee camp in Ethiopia. The network's constitution was formalized with the signing of a protocol between MAECI, UNCHR, and the Universities and partners of the project.

The project is co-financed by Luiss and ALL – the Luiss Alumni Association.

Luiss is also a signatory of the UNHCR Manifesto for an Inclusive University.

Mediterranean Project

The Mediterranean Project was born in 2017 with the aim of educating in need students from different Mediterranean countries, giving them the opportunity to attend bachelor's or master's degree programs in English at Luiss. Upon completion of their course of study, students will be able to continue their university studies in their country of origin, thus contributing to the social and economic progress of the region.

The project is run by a purposely created foundation, the "Fondazione Mediterraneo – Diritto allo studio Luiss Guido Carli", and is co-financed by Luiss and the "Fondazione Terzo Pilastro – Internazionale".

Current partners are the University of Petra in Jordan and the University of Malta. To date, 20 students have been selected: 17 from Jordan, of which 10 are citizens of Jordan and 7 are Palestinian or Syrian refugees that live in Amman under international protection; 3 students were selected from Malta amongst the top students of the country.

The Mediterranean Project intends to extend study opportunities to a higher number of refugees and students in need that also come from other countries in the Euro-Mediterranean region and the Middle East.

With this initiative, Luiss actively participates in reinforcing Italy's role in the region through educating its talented individuals and future leaders—focusing its support on the most vulnerable communities, such as those of refugees.

The Sub-Saharan Africa Project

The Sub-Saharan Africa Project began in 2019 through a three-year partnership agreement between Eni and Luiss to offer joint educational, orientation and geopolitical analysis programs.

The collaboration aims to train the next generation of African leaders, offering talented young people in the region the opportunity to attend high-quality educational programs through scholarships.

In the first year of the project, **4 African students** were selected, while in 2020 **another 10 students** came to Rome to start their educational paths at Luiss

Furthermore, the collaboration between Eni and Luiss continues with the **Geopolitics of Energy** project from the Luiss Observatory on International Security.
